### Syllabus

**LEVEL-1 Computer-Based MCQ Test (100 Marks)**

**PART – A (40 Marks)**

- **General Aptitude:** Arithmetic & Numerical Ability, Quantitative Aptitude, General English, Comprehension, Data Interpretation, Logical Reasoning, General Knowledge & Current Affairs, including the Constitution of India.

**PART – B (60 Marks)**

- **Academic Administration in IITs:** Act and Statutes, Role and Functions of Statutory Bodies (BoG, FC, Senate, BWC), Academic Programmes, Ordinances & Regulations, etc.
- **Service Rules and Acts:** FR & SR, CCS(CCA) Rules, TA Rules and LTC, CCS (Conduct) Rules, CCS(Leave) Rules, CCS (Pension) Rules, Revised Pay Rules, Allowances, Right to Information Act, 2005, NEP 2020, Reservations in recruitment, Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace Act 2013.
- **Finance & Purchase Rules:** GFR 2017, GeM, GST, Budgeting, Accounting and Audit in CABs, Income Tax Act 1961 along with Finance Act 2024, GPF and NPS provisions, Public Financial Management System (PFMS)

**Level – 2 Descriptive and Skill test (60 Marks)**

**Descriptive Test** - Syllabus as above (Level-1), Letter writing, Noting & Drafting, and Essay writing.

**Skill Test - Computer Proficiency:** MS Office, sending email & basic knowledge about Database systems and Proficiency in Typing
